- **NOT EXACT:** Anyone may use this crayon.
- **BACK:** I checked myself in the mirror.

Challenge: Someone made herself a paper crown. NOT EXACT: Someone. BACK: herself.

Accept PROVE IT answers that explain that NOT EXACT pronouns do not name exactly who or what, while BACK pronouns point to the doer. Part 3 and challenge answers will vary if the pronouns are used correctly.
