YOUR JOB Mark the facts you could record from each source. Write T beside trip facts in the book, F beside food facts on Monarch Food, and D beside danger facts on Monarch Dangers.

Monarch Sources

- ① In a book called Monarch Trip, you read that monarch butterflies fly south to Mexico in fall. They gather in mountain forests. In spring, monarchs begin traveling north. The book describes the monarchs' long trip.
- ② A nature center sign called Monarch Food says that monarch caterpillars eat only milkweed leaves. Adult monarchs drink nectar from many flowers. Milkweed gives caterpillars food, while flowers give adult butterflies a sweet drink. These facts fit in a Food category.
- ③ Another sign, Monarch Dangers, explains that people may cut down forest trees in Mexico. This leaves fewer winter homes. Sprays that kill weeds can remove milkweed plants. These facts belong in a Dangers category because they can make life harder for monarchs.
