Beavers Build Near Water

- ① Beavers are large rodents that live near ponds, streams, and rivers. They have wide, flat tails and webbed back feet. A beaver uses its sharp front teeth to cut branches from trees.
- ② Beavers pile branches, mud, and stones across moving water to make dams. A dam slows the water and can form a pond. The pond gives beavers a safer place to build their homes, called lodges.
- ③ Inside a lodge, beavers rest and care for their young. The entrance is often under water, which helps keep some animals out. In my opinion, beavers are clever builders because they change a stream into a pond.
