A Beaver's Pond

- ① At a pond, a beaver uses its sharp teeth to cut small trees. It carries branches to the water and piles them across a stream. The branches slow the moving water and begin a dam.
- ② Pond water rises behind the dam. The deeper water makes a safer place for the beaver's lodge, its home. Other animals, such as frogs and fish, can use the quiet pond water for shelter.
- ③ Beavers keep adding mud and sticks to fix holes in the dam. When rain brings more water, the strong dam holds back much of it. The pond stays deeper, and the lodge entrance remains underwater.

1	How do the branches affect the stream water?	The branches slow the moving water and begin a dam.
2	How does the dam affect the beaver's lodge?	The dam makes the pond deeper, creating a safer place for the lodge and keeping its entrance underwater.
3	What happens when rain brings more water to the pond?	The strong dam holds back much of the water, so the pond stays deeper.
