A Kind Gift, Twice Told

- ① Version One, Korea: Mina lived in a mountain village. She wore a bright hanbok as she carried rice cakes to her grandmother. On a bridge, a hungry magpie cried. Mina gave the bird one rice cake.
- ② The magpie flew to Mina's grandmother's home and dropped a silver key. The key opened a small chest with warm gloves inside. Mina took the gloves to her grandmother, whose hands were cold.
- ③ Version Two, Mexico: Ana lived in a town near cactus fields. She wore a woven huipil and carried sweet bread to abuela. A thirsty rabbit waited by the path. Ana shared water. The rabbit led her to a shop for a warm shawl for abuela.

1	How does each girl help an animal?	Mina gives a magpie a rice cake, and Ana gives a rabbit water.
2	Compare the settings. Where does each version happen?	Mina's story happens in a Korean mountain village, and Ana's story happens in a Mexican town near cactus fields.
3	Compare the plots. What does each animal do after the girl shares?	The magpie brings Mina a silver key, and the rabbit leads Ana to a shop.

PART 3 • YOUR TURN (SAMPLE ANSWER)

Mina and Ana live in different places and help different animals. In both stories, a kind girl shares food or water, and the animal helps her get something warm for her grandmother.

Accept reasonable comparisons supported by the passage. For the shared plot, students may explain that both girls help an animal first, and the animal helps the girl afterward.
