The Monarchs' Long Trip

- ① Each fall, monarch butterflies begin a long journey. They glide south from Canada and the United States to mountain forests in Mexico. This trip is called a migration. The tiny travelers use sunlight and Earth’s magnetic field to help guide them.
- ② Along the way, monarchs need nectar, a sweet liquid inside flowers. Nectar gives them energy for flying. The butterflies also rest in sheltered spots, where branches and leaves protect them from wind and rain. A safe resting place can help a monarch survive.
- ③ In Mexico, millions of monarchs gather in fir trees. Their orange and black wings form clusters that may cover whole branches. The trees give the insects shelter during winter. In spring, the butterflies begin moving north, and a new generation continues the journey.
