A Garden for Our Class

- ① Our class should plant a small vegetable garden by the playground. The garden could have two raised beds. During science time, our class could visit the beds and notice changes in the plants.
- ② One reason is that a garden helps us learn about plants. For example, we can measure a bean plant each week and write its height on a chart. We can see how water, light, and care help the plant grow.
- ③ Another reason is that a garden can give our class fresh food to taste. After peas or lettuce are ready, we can pick them. Sharing the harvest at snack time lets classmates try food that the garden grew.
