My Rain Gauge

- ① First, I chose a clear, straight-sided plastic cup for my rain gauge. I taped a ruler beside the cup, with the zero mark even with the bottom. Then I put the cup on level ground in an open spot.
- ② Next, rain fell into the cup. I waited until the rain stopped, then looked at the water line beside the ruler. I measured from the zero mark to the water line, not from the edge of the cup.
- ③ Last, I wrote the number of centimeters in my weather notebook. The next day, I measured again and compared the two numbers. My notes showed that one rainy day left more water in the cup than the other day.
