Mara Revises Her Report

- ① Mara wrote a short report about the class garden. Her first sentence said, "Our class planted seeds." She added a detail about the small green sprouts. Then she read each sentence aloud to hear how it sounded.
- ② Next, Mara moved one sentence. The report now began with planting, then told about watering, and ended with sprouts. This order helped readers follow the garden's story. She changed the word nice to bright for the yellow flowers.
- ③ Before sharing, Mara checked her work one more time. She used a capital letter at the start of every sentence and a period at the end. She also checked that garden words, such as sprouts, were spelled correctly.
