Garden Sale Helpers

- ① On Monday, the Green Team prepared for its school garden sale. A table held seed packets, small pots, and price tags. Ms. Lee placed a helper card beside each job. The cards had spaces for a first name and a last name. Signing both names showed which student agreed to do the job that day.
- ② Jordan Kim chose the sign that said, "Water the herbs." Jordan printed Jordan Kim on the line at the bottom of the card. The first name came first, and the last name came next. Then Jordan checked that both names were easy to read. A clear signature helped Ms. Lee know who would water the plants.
- ③ At the sale, Amira Soto took the money box job. She wrote Amira Soto on her helper card before the sale began. Near the end, she noticed one card with only the name Kai. Ms. Lee asked Kai to add a last name so the team could tell which Kai had signed up. Kai Rivera finished the card.
