A Year of Visits

- ① On Saturday, Maya Lopez visited the Smithsonian's National Zoo in Washington, D.C., with her uncle Carlos. They watched two giant pandas, Bao Li and Qing Bao, munching bamboo. Carlos explained that the zoo is part of the Smithsonian Institution. Maya sketched the pandas in her notebook and wrote the date beside her picture. She hoped to return during spring break.
- ② Before Thanksgiving, Maya's class made cards for neighbors at Maple Grove Senior Center. Their teacher, Ms. Patel, told them to write each person's name carefully. Maya addressed a card to Mr. James Reed and drew a bright turkey. On Thanksgiving Day, Maya brought the card to the center with her family. Mr. Reed thanked her and placed it near the window.
- ③ In December, Maya planned a trip with Carlos to San Antonio, Texas, where her aunt lives. They wanted to see the River Walk lights before Christmas. Aunt Elena said they could also visit the Alamo and eat breakfast tacos. Maya wrote a note for her calendar: "Christmas in San Antonio with Carlos and Aunt Elena." She checked that every holiday, person's name, and place name began with a capital letter.
