YOUR JOB Underline the two plant words Lina checks in the dictionary. Circle the steps she takes to correct each sign.

Garden Sign Check

- ① On Saturday, Lina helped her uncle make labels for a community garden. She wrote the names of plants on small wooden signs. When she came to the red fruit that grows on a vine, she paused. Lina was not sure whether tomato had one m or two. She did not guess. Instead, she took a beginning dictionary from the shelf.
- ② First, Lina turned to the letter T and used the guide words at the tops of pages to find the right section. She looked at the entry for tomato. It showed tomato spelled t-o-m-a-t-o. Lina noticed that the word has one m. She erased the extra letter on her sign and wrote tomato again. This time, she copied each letter carefully.
- ③ Later, Lina wanted a label for a long, green vegetable. She was unsure how to spell cucumber. She used the same steps: find the first letter, use guide words, and read the entry. The dictionary spelled cucumber c-u-c-u-m-b-e-r. Lina checked her sign against the entry before she hung it by the garden row near the bean plants.
