How Beavers Shape a Place

- ① Beavers are mammals that live near ponds, streams, and rivers. They use their strong teeth to cut branches. Then they carry the wood to the water. A beaver dam is a wall of branches, mud, and stones. The dam slows moving water. This helps create a deeper pond where beavers can swim and find safety.
- ② Beavers build dams for a reason. On land, they move slowly and may be caught by animals such as coyotes. In deeper water, beavers can dive and swim away. A pond also lets them float heavy branches to their homes. These details support the point that dams help beavers stay safe and carry building materials.
- ③ After a dam holds back water, the pond can spread into nearby low land. This change may give frogs, fish, and water birds places to live. It can also cover trees or flood a trail. Over time, a dam may change the area around it. Beavers do more than build homes. Their work can reshape a habitat.
