Beavers Build Ponds

- ① Beavers are busy animals that change the places where they live. They use their strong front teeth to cut small trees and branches. Then they pile wood, mud, and stones across a stream. This dam slows the water and forms a pond. The pond gives beavers a safer place to swim, build, and hide from many predators.
- ② A beaver pond can also help other living things. The still water gives frogs a place to lay eggs. Ducks may rest or feed on the pond. Fish can find calmer water behind the dam. Plants grow along the wet edges, and those plants can provide food and cover for insects, birds, and other animals.
- ③ Beavers need to keep their dams in good shape. Flowing water can carry away mud or loosen branches. A beaver listens for the sound of water leaking through its dam. It may bring more mud and sticks to the spot. By repairing the dam, the beaver helps keep the pond deep enough for its home.
