A Cooler Playground

- ① At Maple Grove School, the playground had little shade. On warm days, students hurried inside during recess because the slide and benches felt hot. The student council suggested planting three young oak trees near the blacktop. The principal agreed to the plan after students explained that trees could give shade and make the playground more pleasant.
- ② Families and teachers helped plant the trees one Saturday. Each tree was placed in a wide hole, covered with soil, and watered. A sign near the trees asks students not to climb on the thin trunks. The student council also made a watering schedule, so different classes can carry buckets to the trees when the weather is dry.
- ③ Oak trees grow slowly, so the new trees will not make much shade right away. Still, the group chose oaks because mature oak trees can have broad branches. Students hope the trees will make recess cooler in future years. They also think caring for the trees will teach classes to look after a shared place.
