Maya's Pinecone Feeder

- ① On a chilly morning, Maya decided to make a simple bird feeder. First, she spread peanut butter over a pinecone with a craft stick. Next, she rolled the sticky pinecone in birdseed. The seeds clung to the peanut butter. After that, Maya tied a string around the top. Soon, her feeder was ready to hang outside.
- ② Before Maya hung the feeder, she chose a quiet tree branch. She asked an adult to help her reach a safe spot. Then, the adult tied the string to a branch away from windows. Maya stepped back and watched. A small chickadee landed nearby. A few minutes later, it pecked at the seeds. The feeder had its first visitor.
- ③ Each day, Maya checked the feeder from indoors. If the seeds were low, she added more while an adult helped. However, she did not put out too much food at once. Wet seeds can spoil. In addition, Maya cleaned the pinecone when it became messy. By caring for the feeder, she gave birds a useful place to find food.
