Our Butterfly Garden

- ① Our class turned an empty corner of the playground into a butterfly garden. First, we pulled weeds and loosened the hard soil with small shovels. Next, we planted milkweed, coneflowers, and other plants that butterflies use for food. We also placed a shallow dish of water near the flowers. The new garden gives butterflies a safe place to visit.
- ② On the first sunny day, we watched the garden carefully. A yellow butterfly landed on a purple coneflower and drank nectar. Soon, two more butterflies fluttered above the milkweed. We wrote down the colors and numbers we saw in a notebook. Seeing butterflies use the plants showed us that our work was helping the insects.
- ③ The garden needs care even after planting day ends. Each week, a small team checks whether the soil is dry and adds water when needed. Another team removes weeds so the flowers have room to grow. In fall, we will leave some seed heads for birds to eat. By caring for the garden, our class can help wildlife all year.
