## FACT

A fact is a statement that can be checked and shown to be true. You can look for proof in a reliable source or by observing it.

A triangle has three sides.

## OPINION

An opinion tells what someone thinks or feels. An author can use reasons and evidence to support an opinion, but the opinion is not proven true or false like a fact.

Winter is the coziest season.
