The Moonlit Map

- ① On the evening before the town festival, Maya helped her grandfather tidy his boat shed. A fierce wind rattled the loose windowpanes and scattered papers across the floor. Under a coil of rope, Maya found a faded map with a note: "Follow the silver path when the moon is high." Her grandfather smiled but would not explain the mysterious message.
- ② At dusk, Maya and her grandfather walked to the riverbank. The map showed a narrow trail beside the water. When the moon rose, its light made a bright stripe on the river. "That must be the silver path," Maya said. They followed the gleaming reflection until they reached an old dock. There, a small metal box rested beneath a weathered plank.
- ③ Inside the box was a brass compass and another note. It said, "A true guide points home, even after a winding journey." Maya first thought the note meant the compass would lead them through every street. Then she understood that her grandfather had planned the search to teach her something. The compass pointed north, but her grandfather's patient advice also helped her find her way when she felt uncertain.

2	What does the phrase “silver path” mean in the story?	It means the bright stripe of moonlight reflected on the river.
3	What does weathered mean when it describes the plank?	Weathered means old and worn from being outside for a long time.
4	What does the message “A true guide points home” mean in this story?	A true guide helps someone find the right way. The compass gives directions, and Grandfather’s advice helps Maya make decisions.
