Maya's Garden Fair

- ① On Saturday, Maya visited the community garden before the fair began. A **blue** flag fluttered above the gate when a breeze **blew** through the beds. Maya carried a small **pail** to water the young plants. Near a sign, she saw a **pear** tree with two ripe fruits hanging low. She picked up a fallen leaf instead of the fruit.
- ② At the tool shed, Mr. Chen asked Maya to **write** the names of the helpers on a chart. She chose the **right** column for people who had worked since morning. Her friend Luis brought a **pair** of gloves, but he gave one glove to Maya because hers was torn. Together, they filled a bin with weeds.
- ③ Later, judges gave Maya a prize for making the clearest plant labels. She had drawn a **flower** beside each herb and written care steps below it. One label said, "Basil needs sun," while another named mint. Maya knew readers could use the labels to learn which plants they would see at the fair the next day.
