A Better Place to Refill

- ① Our school should add a water bottle filling station near the gym. Many students finish recess or PE feeling thirsty, and the closest fountain is down the hall. A filling station would let students refill reusable bottles quickly. Drinking water helps the body control its temperature, which matters when children are active. Easy access to water could help students return to class ready to learn.
- ② It would also cut down on trash. A typical single-use plastic bottle can take hundreds of years to break down. When students refill bottles, fewer empty bottles go into school trash cans. The station can also show how many plastic bottles its use has saved. Seeing that number grow would remind students that small choices can protect land and water each day.
- ③ Some people may worry that a filling station costs money to install. However, our school should add one near the gym because students need water after active classes. It would make refilling reusable bottles easier and could reduce the number of single-use bottles in trash cans. A station display could also help students see how their choices protect land and water.
