- ② Near the cafeteria, another paper asked volunteers to stack chairs after the family reading night. The note listed a start time of 6:30 and a place to meet. At the bottom, the writer left this ink signature: Owen Park. A paper clip held the note beside a map of the school for visitors arriving after sunset.
- ③ On the hallway bulletin board, a third card thanked helpers for sorting donated books. Its final line said, "Please return the boxes to Room 12." The card ended with Mina Shah. Next to it, a smaller reminder about recycling had only the word Sam at the bottom. Both papers used clear, dark letters that were easy to read.
