Maya's Museum Notes

- ① At the museum, Maya watched a conservator repair a torn map. The conservator placed thin paper under the map, then used a small brush to add paste. A long word did not fit at the end of one line, so she wrote conser- vator on the next line. The mark showed readers that the word continued.
- ② Later, Maya read a label about the map's journey across the ocean. A sailor carried it in a waterproof tube during a long expedi- tion. The break came between syllables, and the rest of the word began on the next line. Maya noticed that no single letter stood alone at either end of the break on paper.
- ③ Before leaving, Maya copied a note for the museum guide. She kept the word historic together because it fit on the line. On another line, she needed the word reus- able, so she placed the first part before the line ended and the rest after it. Her neat writing helped the guide read each word without guessing.
