Ava's Aquarium Labels

- ① At the Riverbend Aquarium, Ava wrote a short display label for the touch tank. Her first draft said, “A clean enviroment helps sea animals stay healthy.” She was not sure about one word, so she opened a print dictionary. She used the guide words at the top of each page, then compared the letters in her draft with the dictionary entry before making a correction.
- ② Next, Ava described an octopus hiding among rocks. In her draft, she wrote, “Its camouflage can make it hard to spot.” The dictionary showed several forms of the word near the entry she needed. Ava read the whole entry, including the pronunciation and example sentence, to be sure she had found the right word. She copied the spelling carefully into her label.
- ③ Finally, Ava added a sentence about nighttime activity: “The octopus is nocternal and hunts after dark.” Her print dictionary did not include a science word she wanted to use later, so she checked a trusted museum website. She chose a source with an expert organization listed and looked for the word in its article. Checking more than one source can help when a spelling still seems unclear.
