### A Dam Changes the Stream

- ① Beavers change a stream by building dams from branches, mud, and stones. A dam slows moving water, so water spreads into a pond. The deeper pond gives beavers a safer place to swim and store food. It also creates a watery home for fish, frogs, insects, and water birds. This change begins with one animal's building work.
- ② As the pond forms, plants grow along its edges. Their roots hold soil in place, which can reduce erosion during rain. The plants also offer food and hiding places to insects. In turn, insects become food for frogs and fish. Herons may visit the pond to catch fish. One change in the stream can therefore lead to several connected changes in the food web.
- ③ People sometimes remove old beaver dams because they worry about flooding near roads or fields. When a dam is removed, water moves faster through that spot. The pond may shrink, leaving less shallow water for frogs and fewer edge plants for insects. However, dam removal can help people protect nearby land from unwanted high water. Decisions about dams affect both people and living things.
