PRONOUN AND ANTECEDENT AGREE

The pronoun agrees with the noun or pronoun it refers to. A reflexive pronoun also matches the person or thing doing the action.

A squirrel washed itself beside the stream.

PRONOUN AND ANTECEDENT DISAGREE

The pronoun does not match its antecedent in number or person. The sentence needs a different pronoun.

4	The choir members shared its costumes.	MISMATCH	Choir members is plural, so its does not agree.
5	Mr. Lee blamed himself for the error.	MATCHES	Mr. Lee is singular, and himself agrees with him.
6	The dogs shook themselves dry.	MATCHES	Dogs is plural, and themselves agrees with them.
7	Maya and Tessa blamed herself for the spill.	MISMATCH	Maya and Tessa names two people, so the reflexive pronoun should be themselves.
8	The robot turned themselves off.	MISMATCH	Robot is singular, so themselves does not agree.
