MODIFIES A VERB

An adverb can modify a verb by telling how an action happens. Ask, “How does the action happen?”

The pianist performed skillfully.

MODIFIES AN ADJECTIVE

An adverb can modify an adjective by making a description stronger or weaker. Ask, “How strong is the description?”

The canyon appeared remarkably deep.
