Tide Pool Field Notes

- ① On Saturday, Maya joined a volunteer team at a rocky tide pool. The group recorded the kinds of animals they saw before the water returned. Maya wrote that sea stars, crabs, and anenomes need a clean enviroment. She also noted that many orginisms hide under wet stones when the sun is bright. Her field notes included the date, location, weahter, and the time of low tide. These details would help the team compare observations from different visits.
- ② Back at the nature center, Maya copied her notes into a report. She checked the tide calender and added the day's water level. Then she listed the measurments taken with a ruler and a thermometer. One reading showed that the temperture of a shallow pool rose quickly in sunlight. Maya wanted her report to be clear because volunteers use the records to notice changes in the shore habbitat over time during each season of study.
- ③ Before sharing the report, Maya used a print dictionary and a trusted online dictionary. She looked up words that seemed uncertain instead of guessing from memory. The entries gave the correct spelling, showed syllable breaks, and explained each word's meaning. Maya learned that a spell-checker can miss an error when a mistyped word is also a real word. For example, it might not flag tide when a writer meant time. Careful checking helps readers trust scientific observations.
