A Dive to the Deep

- ① At night, a research team lowered an unmanned submersible into the Pacific Ocean. The vehicle carried cameras, lights, and a manipulator, a mechanical arm that can collect small objects. Far below the surface, sunlight could not reach the water. The scientists watched on a screen as the submersible moved past coral, fish, and drifting particles. Its strong lamps revealed a habitat that few people have seen directly during a deep-sea expedition near an underwater mountain.
- ② Near the seafloor, the camera recorded a bioluminescent squid. In the dark water, its body gave off brief blue-green flashes. The squid released a cloud of ink and vanished behind a rock. The crew also saw translucent shrimp near the lamps. Light passed through their nearly clear bodies, making their internal shapes faintly visible. These animals were part of a community adapted to conditions of darkness, cold, and enormous pressure on the ocean floor below them.
- ③ At one site, the submersible approached a hydrothermal vent, an opening in Earth's crust that releases heated, mineral-rich water. The vent formed near volcanic rock, where seawater became hot underground. Around it grew giant tube worms and tiny microorganisms. The team collected water samples to study these small living things. Unlike plants, many vent organisms use chemicals from the water as an energy source. That process supports a crowded ecosystem in a place without sunlight.

Translucent means allowing some light to pass through. Light passed through the shrimp's nearly clear bodies, and their internal shapes were faintly visible.
4	The Greek forms hydro and therm mean water and heat. Predict the meaning of hydrothermal in paragraph 3, then use a detail from the passage to check your prediction.	Hydrothermal means involving hot water. The vent released heated water, and seawater became hot underground.
