HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read each chant aloud once, then invite children to say it with you before they mark the page. Listen for children joining the repeated words and refrains, not for independent reading of the printed words.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • HEAR IT

SAY "Listen to each little chant. Say it with me, then circle the word you hear again."

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Say this with me: "Swing, swing, swing. Birds fly over the hill." I will read the words: swing, sing, birds. Which word did you hear again? Circle it.	swing
b	Say this with me: "Blue, blue sky shines bright. Clouds float by." I will read the words: bright, blue, clouds. Which word did you hear again? Circle it.	blue
c	Say this with me: "Step, step down the street. Friends wave." I will read the words: street, friends, step. Which word did you hear again? Circle it.	step

PART 2 • TRACE IT

SAY "Say this with me: "Clap, clap, clap, we clap in time." Which word did you say again? Trace the gray word in the first box. Say this with me: "Hum, hum, hum, a quiet tune." Which word did you say again? Trace the gray word in the second box. Say this with me: "March, march, march, around the room." Which word did you say again? Trace the gray word in the third box."

- Box 1: **clap**
- Box 2: **hum**
- Box 3: **march**

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Circle answers are swing, blue, and step. Accept recognizable tracing of clap, hum, and march, and note whether each child joins the choral repeated words.
