HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read all directions and choices aloud. Students join a short repeated chant, identify its event order by circling words, then use the three tracing boxes as prompts for an oral, ordered personal story. Listen for complete sentences, clear voice level, steady pacing, and first, next, last order.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • HEAR ORDER

SAY “Say this three-line chant with me two times: “I clap. I jump. I sit.” Keep your voice clear and steady. Listen to the chant again before each question.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Listen: “I clap. I jump. I sit.” Which word did you hear first? I will read clap, sit, jump. Circle one word.	clap
b	Listen: “I clap. I jump. I sit.” Which word did you hear in the middle? I will read sit, jump, clap. Circle one word.	jump
c	Listen: “I clap. I jump. I sit.” Which word did you hear last? I will read jump, clap, sit. Circle one word.	sit

PART 2 • MY STORY

SAY “Can you tell a partner about something you did in three complete sentences? Point to **FIRST**, **NEXT**, and **LAST** as you tell your story, then trace each word.”

- Box 1: **FIRST**
- Box 2: **NEXT**
- Box 3: **LAST**

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Hear Order answers are clap, jump, sit, in that order. Accept developing tracing of **FIRST**, **NEXT**, and **LAST**, and note whether each student can orally tell a personal experience in three ordered complete sentences with an audible, steady voice.
