HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read each prompt aloud and give students time to circle one large choice. Invite partners to take turns asking the complete questions and retelling the short events. Listen for students who wait, stay on the topic, and use clear complete sentences.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • ASK IT

SAY “Look at the three question words in each row. I will tell you what a friend says and what you want to find out. Which question word fits? Circle it, then ask your partner a whole question.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Your friend says, “I play a game.” You want to find out the place. Which question word fits, where, who, or when? Circle the word you choose.	where
b	Your friend says, “I have a new book.” You want to find out the book's name. Which question word fits, when, what, or where? Circle the word you choose.	what
c	Your friend says, “My cousin sings.” You want to find out which person sings. Which question word fits, where, when, or who? Circle the word you choose.	who

PART 2 • TELL ORDER

SAY “Listen to each short event story. Which number tells when the named event happened? Circle a number, then take turns retelling the story with first, next, and last.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Listen: Sam hopped, then Sam clapped, then Sam sat. Which number tells when Sam clapped, 1, 2, or 3? Circle the number you choose.	2
b	Listen: Ava drew a square, then Ava drew a star, then Ava drew a circle. Which number tells when Ava drew a square, 1, 2, or 3? Circle the number you choose.	1
c	Listen: Leo whispered, then Leo spoke, then Leo listened. Which number tells when Leo listened, 1, 2, or 3? Circle the number you choose.	3

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Ask It answers are where, what, and who. Tell Order answers are 2, 1, and 3. Accept oral questions and retells that are on topic, understandable, and spoken in complete sentences, with appropriate turn-taking.
