Teacher-led print tracking and book-word matching.

HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Model with the different sentence "Fish swim." Point from left to right, name the space between the words, and point out the capital first letter and period at the end. Then use the spoken scripts while students make the marks on the page.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • PRINT PATH

SAY "We read across a row from left to right. When a row ends, our eyes sweep back to the left for the next row. Can you follow the print path?"

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Look at the first row. Which word is first when we read from left to right? Circle it.	We
b	After your eyes finish the row above, they sweep back to the left side of this row. Which word begins this row? Circle it.	Start
c	Look at this row. Which word is last when we read from left to right? Circle it.	spaces

PART 2 • BOOK WORDS

SAY "On the left are words that name people or a part of a book. On the right are words that tell what each one means. I will read all the words. Can you draw a line from each left word to its match?"

- **author** matches **writes**
- **illustrator** matches **draws**
- **title** matches **name**

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Print Path answers are first cell, first cell, and third cell. In Book Words, match author to writes, illustrator to draws, and title to name.
