HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read each prompt aloud and give students time to mark the page. Students find capital letters by circling them, then connect each capital letter to its lowercase partner.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • CIRCLE CAPITALS

SAY “In each row, listen as I name the letters. Which one is a capital letter? Circle it.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Look at m, T, and n. Which one is a capital letter? Circle it.	T
b	Look at R, b, and d. Which one is a capital letter? Circle it.	R
c	Look at g, q, and L. Which one is a capital letter? Circle it.	L

PART 2 • MATCH PARTNERS

SAY “Look at the capital letters on the left and the lowercase letters on the right. Can you draw a line from each capital letter to the same letter in lowercase?”

- **A** matches **a**
- **M** matches **m**
- **S** matches **s**

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Circle answers are T, R, and L. Match A to a, M to m, and S to s; accept lines that clearly connect each matching pair.
