HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read each part aloud and give students time to look at the large print before they mark the page. Students show letter knowledge by matching capital letters to lowercase letters, then by printing the letter they see beside each box.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • MATCH LETTERS

SAY “Look at the capital letters on the left and the lowercase letters on the right. Which lowercase letter matches each capital letter? Draw a line to each match.”

- **C** matches **c**
- **M** matches **m**
- **S** matches **s**

PART 2 • WRITE LETTERS

SAY “Look at the letter beside each box. What letter will you write in the box? Write the same letter in each box.”

- Box 1 (beside A): **A**
- Box 2 (beside t): **t**
- Box 3 (beside R): **R**

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Match C to c, M to m, and S to s. Accept clear, recognizable letter forms that match the printed case: A, t, and R.
