HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read each question aloud while students look at the large marks. Students show left-to-right tracking by circling a mark in each row, then show top-to-bottom writing by tracing one box at a time from the top down.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • LOOK ACROSS

SAY “Put your finger at the left side of each row. Move your finger across the row to the right, then listen to each question.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	As you move from left to right, which shape do you touch first? Circle it.	circle
b	As you move from left to right, which shape do you touch last? Circle it.	diamond

PART 2 • TRACE DOWN

SAY “Look at the top box. Can you trace its gray letter? When you finish, can you trace the gray letter in the box below it, and then the gray letter in the lowest box?”

- Box 1: **m**
- Box 2: **s**
- Box 3: **t**

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Accept the circle in the first cell of row 1 and the last cell of row 2. Accept recognizable traced m, s, and t completed in top-to-bottom order.
