HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read each part aloud and point to the words as you say them. Students first match names that begin with capital letters, then write their own first and last names. Look for accurate name spelling and a capital letter at the beginning of each name.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • MATCH NAMES

SAY “Listen as I read the names in both columns. For each name on the left, can you draw a line to the same name on the right that begins with a capital letter?”

- **ava** matches **Ava**
- **liam** matches **Liam**
- **noah** matches **Noah**

PART 2 • WRITE NAMES

SAY “Say your first and last name quietly. Can you write your first name in the first box and your last name in the second box, starting each name with a capital letter?”

- Box 1 (beside First): **Student's first name, accurately printed and beginning with a capital letter.**
- Box 2 (beside Last): **Student's last name, accurately printed and beginning with a capital letter.**

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Match lines: ava to Ava, liam to Liam, and noah to Noah. Accept each written name if it matches the student's recorded name and begins with a capital letter, including conventional internal capitals or hyphens.
