HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

A noun is a word that names a person, place, or thing. Model the idea with words such as doctor, garden, and toy, then read every printed choice aloud as students mark their answers.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • CIRCLE IT

SAY “Listen as I read the words in each row. Find the word that names the kind of noun I ask about.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Listen: mom, park, ball. Which word names a person? Circle it.	mom
b	Listen: dog, home, cup. Which word names a place? Circle it.	home
c	Listen: sun, dad, school. Which word names a thing? Circle it.	sun

PART 2 • TRACE NAMES

SAY “Can you trace the first gray word, the name of a person? Can you trace the next gray word, the name of a place? Can you trace the last gray word, the name of a thing?”
