HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read each source aloud before reading its rows. Students listen for information from the source, then circle the word that answers each question. This sheet shows students finding details from a text source and from a person's spoken words.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • BOOK FACTS

SAY “I will read words from a book about frogs: “Frogs live near ponds. They eat insects. Their strong legs help them jump.” Listen to each question and the words in its row. Which word answers the question from the book?”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	The book says frogs live near ponds. I will read the words: pond, nest, cave. Which word tells where frogs live?	pond
b	The book says frogs eat insects. I will read the words: leaves, rocks, insects. Which word tells what frogs eat?	insects
c	The book says strong legs help frogs jump. I will read the words: wings, legs, fins. Which word tells what helps a frog jump?	legs

PART 2 • GARDENER TALK

SAY “Now listen to what a gardener says: “Seeds need water to start growing. Young plants need sunlight. A plant can grow from a seed.” Listen to each question and the words in its row. Which word answers the question from the gardener?”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	The gardener says seeds need water to start growing. I will read the words: milk, water, sand. Which word tells what seeds need to start growing?	water
b	The gardener says young plants need sunlight. I will read the words: sun, moon, snow. Which word tells what young plants need?	sun
c	The gardener says a plant can grow from a seed. I will read the words: rock, leaf, seed. Which word tells what a plant can grow from?	seed

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Book Facts answers: pond, insects, legs. Gardener Talk answers: water, sun, seed. Accept a clearly circled correct word, with prompting or repeated reading as needed.
