HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read the story in Part 1 aloud before students mark any answers, then read every choice aloud for each row. Students listen for characters, setting, and events, then use the same details to orally retell the story in order.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • STORY CLUES

SAY “Listen to this story: On a rainy morning, Mia found a tiny dragon under a red bench, Mia shared her umbrella while the dragon flew beside her, and at home Mia gave the dragon a warm cookie. Remember the story as you answer.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	The choices say Mia, dragon, and dog. Who found the dragon? Circle the word.	Mia
b	The choices say school, bench, and home. Where did Mia find the dragon? Circle the word.	bench
c	The choices say hat, cookie, and umbrella. What did Mia share? Circle the word.	umbrella

PART 2 • STORY ORDER

SAY “Think about what happened first, next, and last. Say the events in order as you circle each word.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	The choices say umbrella, bench, and cookie. What word goes with the first thing that happened, when Mia found the dragon under it? Circle the word.	bench
b	The choices say bench, cookie, and umbrella. What word goes with the next thing that happened, when Mia shared it? Circle the word.	umbrella
c	The choices say cookie, umbrella, and bench. What word goes with the last thing that happened, when Mia gave it to the dragon? Circle the word.	cookie

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Part 1 answers are Mia, bench, and umbrella. Part 2 answers are bench, umbrella, and cookie, and accept an oral retell that says Mia found the dragon, shared her umbrella, and gave the dragon a cookie.
