HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read each prompt aloud and pause for students to talk with a partner before they mark the page. Students plan a writing idea by deciding who may read it and what job the writing can do. Listen for partner suggestions that connect the idea to an audience or purpose.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • WHO READS?

SAY “Listen to each writing idea. Whisper to a partner about who might read it, then circle the word that names that reader.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	You are planning a note that says, “I had fun playing with you. Please play again.” Who might read your note? Read the choices: Friend, Family, Class. Circle who might read it.	Friend
b	You are planning a note that says, “I love you, Grandma.” Who might read your note? Read the choices: Friend, Family, Class. Circle who might read it.	Family
c	You are planning a book about school rules for children in your class. Who might read your book? Read the choices: Friend, Family, Class. Circle who might read it.	Class

PART 2 • WRITING JOBS

SAY “The left words are Invitation, Story, and AllAbout. The job words are Teach, Invite, and Entertain. Tell a partner one idea for each kind of writing, then draw lines to match each writing kind to its job.”

- **Invitation** matches **Invite**
- **Story** matches **Entertain**
- **AllAbout** matches **Teach**

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Who Reads? answers are Friend, Family, Class, in order. Writing Jobs matches Invitation to Invite, Story to Entertain, and AllAbout to Teach; accept clear lines even if they cross.
