HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read the scripts aloud while students look at the large printed words. Students connect word pairs and identify spoken clues for words in the names Columbus Day, Indigenous Peoples' Day, and Yorktown Victory Day.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • MATCH WORDS

SAY “Look at the words in the left column and the right column. I will read the words in each column. Can you draw a line to join words that belong together in a holiday name?”

- **Columbus** matches **Day**
- **Indigenous** matches **Peoples**
- **Yorktown** matches **Victory**

PART 2 • CIRCLE WORDS

SAY “Listen carefully as I read the choices in each row. Circle the word that answers each question.”
