HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read every choice aloud and give students time to make each mark. Students show that they know key facts about Veterans Day by identifying when it happens and whom it honors.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • CIRCLE FACTS

SAY “Listen as I read each choice in every row. After you hear the question, circle one answer.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Veterans Day happens in which month? The choices are November, January, and July. Circle the month you hear.	November
b	Veterans Day is on which number day in its month? The choices are 10, 11, and 12. Circle the number you hear.	11
c	Veterans Day honors which people? The choices are farmers, singers, and veterans. Circle the word you choose.	Veterans

PART 2 • DRAW LINES

SAY “I will read the words in both columns. Which word on the right tells about each word on the left? Draw a line to make each match.”
