HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read each short situation and the large choice words aloud. Listen for students who choose actions that give others a fair turn, share materials, or help the group finish together. In the matching part, read every word before students draw their lines.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • CHOOSE A TEAM CHOICE

SAY "I will tell you about a group problem and read the three words in each row. Listen for the choice that helps everyone. Which word shows a good team choice?"

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	You and Kai want the same blue marker. The words are WAIT, GRAB, and PUSH. Which choice helps both children have a turn?	WAIT
b	Your table has one box of crayons for everyone. The words are KEEP, SHARE, and HIDE. Which choice helps everyone use the crayons?	SHARE
c	Your group is putting books back, and one friend has many books to carry. The words are QUIT, YELL, and HELP. Which choice helps the group finish together?	HELP

PART 2 • TEAM WORD MATCH

SAY "Look at the words on the left and the words on the right. I will read them all. Draw a line from each word on the left to the word that goes with it. Which word on the right goes with each word on the left?"

- **WAIT** matches **URNS**
- **SHARE** matches **TOYS**
- **HELP** matches **TEAM**

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Circle-row answers are WAIT, SHARE, and HELP, in that order. Matching lines are WAIT to TURNS, SHARE to TOYS, and HELP to TEAM; accept clearly intended lines.
