HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read each situation and the words in its row aloud. Students circle the word that names the best classroom choice, then briefly invite volunteers to explain their thinking aloud.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • OWN IT

SAY "Listen to each classroom situation. I will read the three words in each row. Circle the word that names the best choice."

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	You knock over a block tower. Which choice helps you take responsibility? Circle HELP, HIDE, or LAUGH.	HELP
b	You find a pencil that is not yours. Which choice respects someone else's property? Circle KEEP, RETURN, or BREAK.	RETURN
c	You spill water on the floor. Which choice is honest? Circle HIDE, BLAME, or TELL.	TELL

PART 2 • TOGETHER

SAY "Listen to each classroom situation. I will read the three words in each row. Circle the word that helps everyone in our class."

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	You want to use the slide, and another child is using it. Which choice shows self-control? Circle WAIT, PUSH, or YELL.	WAIT
b	You have crayons, and a classmate needs one. Which choice is kind? Circle GRAB, SHARE, or HIDE.	SHARE
c	Your group is cleaning up the classroom. Which choice helps the group? Circle QUIT, ARGUE, or HELP.	HELP
