HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • CIRCLE FACTS

SAY “Listen as I read each row. After each question, circle one word.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	I will read the words: play, work, sleep. Which word tells what Labor means in the holiday name?	work
b	I will read the months: August, October, September. Which month has Labor Day?	September
c	I will read the words: holiday, weekend, weekday. Which kind of day is Labor Day?	holiday
