HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Use this sheet after shared instruction about Veterans Day. Read every choice aloud, then have students show what they know by circling and drawing lines.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • LISTEN AND CIRCLE

SAY “We are thinking about Veterans Day. I will read each row. Listen to the choices, then circle one answer in each row.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Listen: cake, thanks, bedtime. Which word could you say to show you appreciate a veteran? Circle it.	thanks
b	Listen: served, painted, jumped. Which word tells what a veteran did in the military? Circle it.	served
c	Listen: March, July, November. Which month has Veterans Day? Circle it.	November

PART 2 • DRAW LINES

SAY “I will read the words and number in both columns. Which word or number on the right goes with each one on the left? Draw a line for each match.”

- **November** matches **11**
- **Veteran** matches **served**

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Circle: thanks, served, November. Match Thank to you, November to 11, and Veteran to served.
