**HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE**

Read each row aloud and point to each choice as you say it. Students show what they know about Thanksgiving Day by circling a choice, then tracing two holiday words.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

**PART 1 • CIRCLE FACTS**

**SAY** "I will read the choices in each row. Listen to the question, then circle one choice."
