HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Use this sheet after a class calendar talk about New Year's Day. Read each choice aloud, then have students show what they remember about the holiday's date. Students finish by tracing the month and number in the date.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • FIND THE DATE

SAY “We are thinking about New Year's Day. Listen as I read the choices in each row. Can you circle the month or number that belongs in New Year's Day's date?”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Listen to these month names: January, June, December. Which month is New Year's Day in? Circle it.	January
b	Listen to these numbers: 25, 1, 4. Which number is the date for New Year's Day? Circle it.	1

PART 2 • TRACE THE DATE

SAY “Look at the gray month word and the gray number. Can you trace each one to make the date for New Year's Day?”

- Box 1: **January**
- Box 2: **1**

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Accept circles around January in the first row and 1 in the second row. Accept tracing that follows the gray model for January and 1.
