HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Use this sheet after a brief lesson about the February holiday. Read every choice aloud, then have students show the holiday words they recognize by circling and tracing.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • CIRCLE WORDS

SAY "I will read the words in each row. Listen to my question, then circle one word."

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	I will read Abraham, George, Martin. Which first name do you hear in George Washington Day?	George
b	I will read Lincoln, Adams, Washington. Which last name do you hear in George Washington Day?	Washington
c	I will read Presidents, Veterans, Pilgrims. Which word do you hear in the common name for this holiday?	Presidents

PART 2 • TRACE LETTERS

SAY "Look at the word beside each box. What sound does the word start with? Trace the gray first letter in each box."

- Box 1 (beside George): **G**
- Box 2 (beside Washington): **W**
- Box 3 (beside Presidents): **P**
